Travel Itinerary

Day 1 | Arrival & Free Day (1350mtr/ 30 minutes' drive to hotel)

- Welcome to Nepal. Your sacred journey to the Abode of Lord Shiva begins.
- Arrival at Kathmandu Airport and transfer to your hotel.
- Rest of the day free for personal activities.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.
- **Meals:** Dinner

Note:

Suitcases will be kept at the hotel. You will carry your luggage in a duffle bag provided by us with a 10 kg weight limit.

Day 2 | Kathmandu to Keyrung (2600Mtrs)

- Real yatra begins today as we leave Kathmandu and drive to Rasuwagadhi (Nepal–China Border).
- Complete Nepal-side immigration formalities.
- Proceed to China immigration and Tibet security check.
- Clearance time may vary depending on the number of passengers/groups.
- After border formalities, proceed to Keyrung in Tibet (25 km / approx. 45 minutes).
- Arrive in Keyrung, check in to the hotel, and enjoy a free day.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Note:

- If immigration cannot be cleared due to unforeseen reasons, stay will be arranged on the Nepal side of the border.

Day 3 | Keyrung to Saga (300Km/6hrs/4500Mtrs) or Dongma

- After breakfast, proceed to Saga.
- Gradual elevation gain, reaching a maximum of 4,820 meters.
- Settle at Saga at an altitude of 4,500 meters.
- Lunch en route as packed meals with limited options.
- Arrive in Saga and check in for an overnight stay.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner.

Day 4 | Saga/New Dongma to Manasarovar (450Km/10hrs/4550Mtrs)

- After breakfast, proceed to Holy Manasarovar Lake.
- Before hotel check-in, complete the Parikrama of Manasarovar Lake.
- Continue to your accommodation at Manasarovar.
- Overnight stay at Mud House / Hotel.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Note:

1. Accommodation at Manasarovar is very basic with multiple-sharing rooms and outside toilets (no complaints should be raised regarding accommodation).
2. No bathing allowed at Manasarovar—neither at the lake nor outside.
3. Guests may perform puja on their own; no arrangements will be made.
4. If Pony/Porter is required for Parikrama, inform the local guide today. Due to high demand, availability may be difficult, and we are not responsible if it cannot be arranged.
5. Even after payment, pony/porter availability is not guaranteed.

Day 5 | Mansarovar to Darchen (40Km/1hrs/4600Mtrs)

- After breakfast, proceed to Darchen, the last town before starting the Kailash Parvat Parikrama.
- Guests can complete any remaining shopping for the Parikrama.
- Explore the town on your own.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

If allowed one can visit Astapad with additional cost, from where one can have very good Darshan of South Face & Astapad is a place where first Jain Trirthankar Guru **Rishavdev** got enlightenment

Day 6 | Darchen – Yamadwar– Diraphuk (12KM/4hrs/4900Mtrs)

- After breakfast, packed lunch will be provided (limited options; to be carried by each guest).
- Drive to Yamadwar (15–20 minutes), the starting point of the Parikrama.
- Day 1 of Parikrama: relatively easy walk of 12 km, taking approximately 4–6 hours depending on individual pace.
- En route, enjoy darshan of Kailash Parvat.
- Arrive at Diraphuk with a devotion-filled heart.
- Overnight stay at Tea House.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Note:

- Guests who cannot do the Parikrama will stay at the hotel in Darchen with additional cost.

Additional Notes:

1. Those Who are not going for Parikrama will stay at Darchen at same or different hotel with additional cost depending upon hotel
2. Accommodation at **Diraphuk** will be very basic with multiple sharing rooms with Outside toilets (Guest should not complain regarding accommodation here)
3. No bath at **Diraphuk** / No Mineral water
4. Khichadi or similar food served for dinner

Day 7 | Diraphuk – Zuthulphuk (22KM/10–12hrs/5630Mtrs)

- Today is the most challenging day of the Yatra.
- Walk 22 km, crossing the highest pass in the world, Dolma La Pass (5,630 meters above sea level).
- The first 8–10 km are tough due to steep ascent.
- After crossing Dolma La Pass and reaching the first tea house, the path becomes easier.
- Continue walking until Zuthulphuk.
- Overnight stay at Zuthulphuk.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner.

Note:

- 1) Those Who are not going for Parikrama will stay at Darchen at same or different hotel with additional cost depending upon hotel
- 2) Accommodation at **Zuthulphuk** will be very basic with multiple sharing rooms with Outside toilets (Guest should not complain regarding accommodation here)
- 3) No bath at **Zuthulphuk** / No Mineral water
- 4) Khichadi or similar food served for dinner

Day 8 | Zuthulphuk to Darchen & Transfer to Saga /New Dongma (8Km + 450Km/8hrs /4500Mtrs)

- Final day of Parikrama with a comparatively easy 8 km walk (approx. 2 hours).
- Reach the Parikrama end point where the vehicle will be waiting.
- Proceed by vehicle to Saga or New Dongma.
- Overnight stay.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Note:

- Rooms are not provided at Darchen for those returning from Parikrama on Day 3.
- Guests may freshen up in another room if available.

Day 9 | Saga /New Dongma – Keyrung (5hrs) (335Km/5hrs)

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel.
- Proceed to Keyrung for the final night in Tibet (China).
- Arrive in Keyrung and take rest.
- Overnight stay.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner.

Day 10 | Keyrung to Kathmandu (8hrs) (200Km/8-9hrs)

- After breakfast, proceed to the Nepal–China border (approx. 45 minutes).
- Complete immigration and border formalities.
- Drive to Kathmandu (around 7 hours).
- Arrive in Kathmandu and check in for an overnight stay.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Today will be your day , this day has been kept as a buffer day in case of any delay or any other issue , so either we can do additional sightseeing of Kathmandu covering **Kathmandu Durbar Sqare , Chandragiri Hills & Swayambbunath stupa** or you can head back to your home town

Day 11 | Kathmandu Sightseeing (7hrs Max)

- After breakfast, proceed for Kathmandu sightseeing covering: (Pashupatinath Temple, Guheshwori (Shakti Peeth), Jal Narayan & Kathmandu Durbar Square)
- Return to the hotel and overnight stay.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner.

Day 12 | Chandragiri Hills & Swayambunath stupa (6hrs max)

- After breakfast, proceed to Chandragiri Hills, a major tourist attraction in Kathmandu.
- Enjoy a ropeway ride and panoramic views of Kathmandu Valley and the Himalayan ranges (weather permitting).
- Visit Swayambhunath Stupa, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Return to the hotel and overnight stay.
- **Meals:** Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner.

Day 13 | Departure

- Today will be the end of your holy Yatra
- After breakfast, transfer to the airport as per your flight schedule.
- **Meals:** Breakfast only.
